

Old Town Scottsdale Itineraries — from The Rally House

14241 N 54th Street, Scottsdale, AZ 85254 · Old Town is 11 miles south, about 18 minutes down Scottsdale Road. Rideshare runs \$18–30 each way.

The 1-day Old Town itinerary

One drive down, one ride back, and an afternoon at the house in between.

ONE DAY

Galleries, patio lunch, pool break, night out

8:30 a.m.	Breakfast at the house Cook on the kitchen island or grab a quick coffee before you head out; you're not rushing.
9:15 a.m.	Leave the house An 18-minute drive down Scottsdale Road. Leave the car in the free Civic Center garage.
9:45 a.m.	Farmers market or a Main Street café Old Town Farmers Market on Brown Avenue Saturday mornings (Oct–May), or a second coffee and a pastry on a weekday.
10:30 a.m.	Scottsdale Arts District galleries Main Street and Marshall Way. Most galleries open at 10 a.m.; Thursday ArtWalk is the evening version.
12:00 p.m.	Patio lunch A chef-driven room on Fifth Avenue or a Sonoran-style spot a block off Main.
1:30 p.m.	SMoCA and the Civic Center lawns Low-effort, shaded, and good for an hour of contemporary art and public sculpture.
2:30 p.m.	Shopping Turquoise and western wear on Brown Avenue, or walk north to Fashion Square for the flagships.
4:00 p.m.	Back to the house 18 minutes north. Pool and downtime — the whole point of basing in North Scottsdale.

7:00 p.m.	Rideshare back for dinner \$18–30 each way. The Arts District side stays calm; the Entertainment District gets loud.
9:30 p.m.	Pick your night A quiet gallery-hopping walk, or a rooftop bar in the Entertainment District.
11:30 p.m.	Rideshare home Back to a quiet street. No parking stress, no designated driver.

The 2-day Old Town itinerary

Art and a long dinner on day one; shopping, spa, and a night out on day two.

DAY 1

Galleries, gardens, and a long patio dinner

9:00 a.m.	Breakfast at the house, then drive down 18 minutes south. Park free in the Civic Center garage.
10:00 a.m.	Scottsdale Arts District Main Street and Marshall Way. A two-hour wander, not a march.
12:30 p.m.	Lunch on Fifth Avenue Order the Sonoran-style something and sit outside.
2:00 p.m.	SMoCA, Civic Center, Old Adobe Mission The historic few blocks in one easy loop.
3:30 p.m.	Back to the house Pool time and the firepit. You earned the break.
7:00 p.m.	Rideshare to a long patio dinner Book the table a week out for a weekend.

DAY 2

Shopping, spa, and a night out

8:30 a.m.	Coffee on Main Street Then the Saturday Farmers Market on Brown Avenue (Oct–May) if it's a weekend.
10:00 a.m.	Fashion Square and Scottsdale Quarter Neiman Marcus, Gucci, and Louis Vuitton at the Square; daily luxury a short drive north at the Quarter.

12:30 p.m.	Lunch, then a spa half-day A Quarter patio for lunch. Book the earliest available slot at a resort spa if you planned ahead.
4:00 p.m.	Back to the house Pool and a nap before the night out.
7:30 p.m.	Entertainment District Rooftop bars and a late dinner. Reserve a table on event weeks.
11:30 p.m.	Rideshare home Two days, two rides home, zero parking headaches — exactly why you base in North Scottsdale.
