

# The Best Golf Courses in Scottsdale — Tee Times from The Rally House

Five courses within thirty minutes of the front door, green fees in and out of season, turn-by-turn directions, and an hour-by-hour plan for a golf day.

## TPC Scottsdale — Stadium Course

The WM Phoenix Open course, 16th hole and all · 9.1 mi / 17 min from the house · \$\$\$

The one everyone wants. You walk the same 16th hole that holds 20,000 screaming people every February, and the rest of the layout is genuinely great desert golf — wide off the tee, brutal around the greens. Peak-season rates are eye-watering and worth it once.

### Directions from 14241 N 54th St

1. North on N 56th St to E Bell Rd.
2. West on Bell Rd to N Hayden Rd.
3. North on Hayden about 4 miles.
4. TPC entrance on the left; bag drop is straight ahead at the clubhouse.

### Good to know

**Timing:** First tee times go out around 6:45am in season — take one, you'll finish by 11.

**Pace:** Expect 4:45 in peak season. Don't book anything within 6 hours.

**Alternative:** The Champions Course next door is half the price and 80% the experience.

## We-Ko-Pa — Saguaro Course

No houses, no cart paths, pure desert · 22 mi / 30 min from the house · \$\$\$

The best pure golf near Scottsdale, and the one low-handicap guests rank first. Coore & Crenshaw routing on tribal land — not a single house, road, or power line in view, and it's actually walkable. Firm, fast, wind-exposed.

## Directions from 14241 N 54th St

1. North on N 56th St, east on E Shea Blvd to the 101.
2. North on Loop 101, east on AZ-87 (Beeline Hwy).
3. Right on N Fort McDowell Rd, follow signs to We-Ko-Pa.
4. Bag drop at the shared Saguaro/Cholla clubhouse.

## Good to know

**Timing:** Longest drive on this list — leave 45 minutes before your tee time.

**Wind:** Afternoon wind is real out here. Morning tee times play 3 shots easier.

**Also:** Play Cholla if Saguaro is booked; both are top-100 public.

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## Troon North — Monument Course

Boulder-strewn North Scottsdale classic · 17 mi / 25 min from the house · \$\$\$

The postcard version of Arizona golf: fairways threaded between house-sized granite boulders under Pinnacle Peak. Monument's namesake par-5 boulder in the middle of the fairway is the most photographed hole in the state.

## Directions from 14241 N 54th St

1. North on N 56th St to E Bell Rd, west to N Scottsdale Rd.
2. North on Scottsdale Rd about 8 miles.
3. East on E Dynamite Blvd.
4. Troon North entrance on the right; bag drop at the main clubhouse.

## Good to know

**Caddie:** Forecaddies are available and genuinely worth it on the Monument.

**Pinnacle:** The Pinnacle course is easier and slightly cheaper if the group is mixed.

**Elevation:** It's 1,000 ft higher than the house — 5–8° cooler all year.

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## Grayhawk — Raptor Course

Closest big-name track, best practice facility · 10 mi / 18 min from the house · \$\$\$

The most efficient good round near the house. Fazio's Raptor is tough and fair, the practice facility is the best public one in Scottsdale, and Phil's Grill afterward is a proper 19th hole. NCAA Championships have been held here.

## Directions from 14241 N 54th St

1. North on N 56th St to E Bell Rd.
2. West on Bell to N Hayden Rd, north to E Thompson Peak Pkwy.
3. East on Thompson Peak.
4. Grayhawk on the left; two clubhouses — Raptor is the north one.

## Good to know

**Timing:** Closest real tee time to the house after TPC — 18 minutes door to bag drop.

**Talon:** Talon is more scenic, Raptor is the better test. Both good.

**After:** Phil's Grill patio, fire pit, and don't skip the fried chicken.

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## The Phoenician Golf Club

Camelback right on top of you, resort polish · 11 mi / 20 min from the house · \$\$

Rebuilt in 2018 into a single 18 that hugs the base of Camelback. Shorter and more forgiving than the desert tracks, which makes it the right call for a mixed-ability group — and you're 8 minutes from Old Town when you finish.

## Directions from 14241 N 54th St

1. South on N 56th St to E Camelback Rd.
2. East on Camelback a half mile.
3. The Phoenician entrance is on the north side.
4. Follow signs to the golf clubhouse and bag drop.

## Good to know

**Mixed groups:** Easiest walk and widest fairways of the five — good for newer players.

**Pair with:** Old Town lunch or the Phoenician's Mowry & Cotton after.

**Rentals:** Best club rental fleet on this list if you flew in without sticks.

| 6:15 am  | <b>Bag drop and range</b><br>Arrive 30–40 minutes early. At Grayhawk make it 60 and use the range — it's the best public one in town. |
| 6:50 am  | <b>Tee off</b><br>Morning rounds play cooler, calmer, and faster. Afternoon wind is the local tax.                                    |
| 11:30 am | <b>19th hole</b><br>Phil's Grill at Grayhawk, the TPC clubhouse deck, or the We-Ko-Pa patio. All have shade and cold beer.            |
| 1:00 pm  | <b>Back to the house</b><br>Pool, putting green, pickleball court — the recovery half of the day happens at home.                     |

## Before you book

**Book peak season early:** January through April is the busiest golf market in America. TPC and Troon North want 60–90 days of notice.

**Summer is 70% off:** June–September the same tee sheets drop to \$60–\$150. Play at 6am and be done before the heat.

**Overseeding closes courses:** Most tracks close 2–3 weeks in October to overseed. Check before you plan an October trip.

**Carts are usually mandatory:** We-Ko-Pa and The Phoenician are the two you can genuinely walk.

**Rentals are fine here:** All five rent current-model TaylorMade or Callaway sets — no need to fly with clubs.
